Job Duties & Responsibilities

- Complete set-up, change over and operation of foam cutting secondary operations machinery including waterjet cutter, horizontal slitter, hand and vertical profile machines, die cutters and down cutter equipment
- Perform all necessary adjustments to produce quality products
- Complete all quality check procedures and paperwork for each job produced
- Perform all area duties when required and as assigned
- Inform supervisor of any safety or quality issues
- Maintain equipment as directed by supervisor
- Maintain a clean working area
- Follow required schedule with regular and consistent attendance
- Comply with all company policies and procedures
- Understand and demonstrate safe work practices at all times to prevent injury of self or others
- Other duties as assigned
